Next follow several groups of options. 1.The first one is for all students. They may choose Languages or ITT in History. The first group (Languages) includes ancient languages (Greek, Latin or Bulgarian), each of them compulsory and 2 lecture courses from the

proposed some 10. The second one (ITT) also consists of compulsory (lectures, seminars, 3 practices) and options - 2 lecture course from the proposed some 4. The options in each group may change their number depending on the ideas of the staff. 2. The next options are in History only and it is a possibility for all students to choose one of them: Medieval Bulgarian History, Bulgarian History (15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> century), Modern and Contemporary Bulgarian History, Ancient History and Thracian Studies, Medieval History, Modern History, Contemporary History, Russian history. In each of them there exist 4 compulsory. As far as the faculty proposes as single subjects Archaeology, Ethnology, History of South and South-Eastern Europe, Archival and Documental Studies we do not have them any more as options in this group. But under certain conditions students have the right to choose each of them as a second BA program.

All the training has its final exam (called State exam). It is written for all the students and written + oral/practical for ITT students only.
